- CCW1 – Missouri Concealed Carry (\$110):** This course is approximately 9-10 hours and exceeds Missouri's minimum training requirements to apply for a concealed carry endorsement. Includes textbook, range supplies, and certificate/affidavit of training for Missouri concealed carry endorsement. A light breakfast will be provided. Please bring a sack lunch. Students will need a semiautomatic handgun AND a revolver with a minimum of 75 rounds per gun (100 recommended). Only commercially-produced ammunition is permitted. NO RELOADS. Handguns and ammunition are not included in the course fee. Rental guns are available by reservation.
- CCW1A – Missouri Concealed Carry – No Textbook (\$95):** This is the Missouri Concealed Carry course for students who wish to share a textbook with another member of their household who is purchasing the course with the textbook. Applications must be received together.
- CCW1B – Missouri Concealed Carry – Underage (\$95):** This is the Missouri Concealed Carry course for students who are under age 21 and not in the military. The only difference is that the course completion certificate is not a valid affidavit of training for a Missouri concealed carry endorsement. Must be at least 16 years of age. If under 18 years of age, student must be accompanied by a family member who is not underage and must have parent's/guardian's permission.

Release, Waiver, Indemnification, Hold Harmless, And Assumption of Risk Agreement



In consideration of David S. Kingsbury and PRS Tactical LLC DBA PRS Tactical (hereinafter referred to as “instructor”); and Green Valley Rifle & Pistol Club Inc., the National Rifle Association (NRA), any assistant instructor, guest speaker, or range safety officer, and any and all other persons or entities involved (hereinafter referred to as “others”) permitting me to attend a course for instruction in the selection, use, and care of firearms and related equipment, and for any associated instruction or activities (hereinafter referred to as “training”); and for use of land, range, building, and other improvements (hereinafter referred to as “premises”), I the undersigned on behalf of myself and my executors, personal representatives, administrators, assignees, heirs, and next of kin do hereby understand and agree to the following:

I agree to indemnify, hold harmless, and defend instructor and others from any and all fault, liabilities, costs, expenses, claims, demands, or lawsuits arising out of, related to, or connected with my presence on, participation in, or use of the instruction or premises, or from any and all acts or omissions committed by me.

I expressly release instructor and others for any and all such claims and liabilities.

While attending this training, firearms will be utilized, and I voluntarily assume any and all risks of using and employing firearms and any associated equipment, understanding those risks inherent in any situation and under any circumstances during training or on the premises include but are not limited to permanent injury and death.

I will not attend training or use facilities after consuming alcohol, illegal or prescription drugs, or any other substance or combination of substances that may impair my mental or physical state or capabilities.

If I am found to have violated this agreement, any range rules or procedures, or any other rules or procedures stated by the instructor, which shall be determined at the sole discretion of the instructor, I understand that I will be dismissed from the training and premises without recourse.

I hereby affirm that I have read this instrument, understand its terms, and am executing it voluntarily. I expressly agree that this instrument is intended to be as broad and inclusive as permitted by law, and that if any provision of this instrument is held invalid or otherwise unenforceable, the enforceability of the remaining provisions shall remain in effect. Turn left on Academy Rd. by the gun club sign.
Go 0.9 miles. Club entrance is on the left.
Meet in the classroom on the left side of the drive.

Reservation and Payment

1. Applications must be accompanied by the full amount due and documentation of any applicable discounts. Acceptable forms of payment include cash, personal checks, cashier's checks, and money orders. Cash is only accepted in person. Make checks payable to David S. Kingsbury.
2. The instructor will contact you to confirm your reservation. Your reservation is not complete until you receive confirmation. If your application is denied, you will receive a full refund.
3. Handgun rentals and the CCW Handgun Shooting Experience are subject to availability of ammunition. The instructor will confirm availability at the same time your course reservation is confirmed.
4. Returned checks are subject to a \$25 fee in addition to the original amount due. The full amount must be paid by cash, cashier's check, or money order. Certificates will be revoked and will not be reissued until full payment is made.

Cancellation and Refund

1. Cancellations made at least 10 days in advance of the course date will receive a full refund, except \$25 will be deducted if you received your textbook in advance.
2. Fees are not refundable if a cancellation is made less than 10 days in advance of the course date but, upon payment of a \$35 course-change fee, may be applied to a future course date within 120 days of the initial course date.
3. If a student does not show up for a reserved course, all fees will be forfeit and will not be applied to a future course.
4. If the instructor dismisses a student from a course for any reason, all fees will be forfeit and will not be applied to a future course.
5. Courses with fewer than 3 students may be cancelled at the instructor's discretion with 7-days notice. In this event, students may choose a full refund or apply their fees to reserve a future course date.
6. Courses are held rain or shine. In the event of severe weather, a course may be postponed at the instructor's discretion.

Participation

1. NO LIVE AMMUNITION IS PERMITTED IN THE CLASSROOM.
2. ANY FIREARMS ENTERING THE CLASSROOM MUST BE CASED AND CHECKED BY THE INSTRUCTOR.
3. STUDENTS MUST FOLLOW GENERAL PRINCIPLES OF FIREARMS SAFETY AT ALL TIMES. BASIC FIREARMS SAFETY WILL BE DISCUSSED AT THE BEGINNING OF THE COURSE. ADDITIONAL INSTRUCTIONS WILL BE GIVEN BEFORE THE LIVE-FIRE EXERCISE. IF YOU ARE NOT SURE OF EXPECTATIONS, ASK.
4. Courses begin promptly at the scheduled start time. Students are expected to be on time.
5. Students must follow all directions and range commands from the instructor while on the range or when handling firearms in the classroom.
6. Disruptive behaviors, profanity, and inappropriate attitudes will not be tolerated.

Required Equipment

- Semiautomatic handgun. *Must be in a case.*
- Revolver. *Must be in a case.*
- A minimum of 75 rounds of commercially produced ammunition. *Reloaded ammunition is not permitted.*
- Ear protection. *If you do not own ear protection, disposable foam earplugs will be available.*
- Eye protection. *Glasses with polycarbonate lenses are acceptable. Non-prescription glasses must be impact-rated. If you do not own eye protection, loaner safety glasses will be available.*
